### Lt. Gov Elvia's Comments, Stories, Fibs, Etc.:

- **Elvia** noted that Chino Kiwanis member Wilbur Richards was mentioned in an *Inland Valley Daily Bulletin* article on April 18, and there was an Aktion Club article in the same newspaper as well.
- **Elvia** recognized the two Clubs in Division 15 that received **2008-09 Distinguished Club** awards: **Pomona Noon** (90 points) and **Upland Foothill** (80 points). The Presidents and Secretaries from each Club received pins.
- **The Division 15 Annual Prayer Breakfast** put on by **Upland-Foothill** will be on **May 12, 7:00 – 8:30 a.m.** at the Upland YMCA. Cost is \$15 per person. ### Election of Lt. Governor for 2010-11:

- **Past Lt. Governor and Nominations Chair Larry Clark** offered the nomination of current **Lt. Governor-Elect Patricia Cridland (Ontario-Parkway)** as the 2010-11 Lt. Governor for Division 15. No other nominations were offered, and **Patricia** will be our Lt. Governor next year by acclamation. We currently have no candidate for 2011-12 Lt. Governor-elect, and both **Elvia** and **Larry** encouraged everyone to go back to their respective clubs and find a Club Past-President to seek that office. Her training at Bass Lake will occur May 14-16.

### **Past Lt. Governor and Region 13 Trustee Larry Clark (Claremont):**

- Online addition and deletion of members is now live on the KiwanisOne website ([www.kiwanisone.org](http://www.kiwanisone.org)). This is the same website that Secretaries utilize for monthly reports. The KiwanisOne site is now the official one for Kiwanis members, while [www.kiwanis.org](http://www.kiwanis.org) now will primarily serve non-members. He also noted that the Club Locator on [www.kiwanis.org](http://www.kiwanis.org) that is used by people interested in joining Kiwanis now will send that interest notification to a number of Clubs in the geographic area of the prospective new member. Clubs need to respond quickly to those notifications so that they are not beaten to the punch by rival Clubs!
- Our very own **Fred and Rita Nelsen (Ontario)** are featured in this month's *Kiwanis Magazine* as one of the "Kiwanis Couples"! Someone noted that this a human interest story, not a crime story.... Check it out!
- **Larry** pleaded for more participation by Division 15 Clubs in our project **Water for People**. Half the year is gone and only **Claremont** has contributed so far! It would be nice if each Club contributed at least \$200. He's counting on each of you to pursue this goal at your next Board Meeting!

### **60-second Club Reports (or Elvia's "What have you done for me tomorrow?"):**

- **Chino** is having a membership drive on May 5 featuring the Mayor. They are also doing a skin cancer screening on May 12 for Chino residents.
- **Chino Hills** is doing a joint bingo fundraiser with *Rotary*. Their Key Club at Ayala H.S. had a carnival fundraiser for St. Joseph's Hospital in Orange.
- **Claremont** served lunch for a Senior Health Fair in town, as well as cooked pancakes for the Kiwanis/Rotary Easter Egg Hunt. Twenty-two (22) **Claremont** members and sponsored youth worked on the Habitat for Humanity project on **Kiwanis One Day**. They removed two walls from a house in Covina, working 8 – 2:30.
- **Montclair** had a pancake breakfast for their Easter Egg Hunt earlier this month. They also did a community service project at Opare in Montclair.
- **Ontario** painted their way into the history books in a Kiwanis One Day project at the *Kids Come First* pediatric clinic in Ontario. Walls, walls, and more walls...
- **Ontario Parkway** members continue to read at Sultana Elementary School in Ontario and are giving away thousands of books. They have a Women of Vision homeless project. And the Club didn't win the Rubber Ducky race on April 17 – the Loma Linda Club won 1<sup>st</sup> place. Quack Quack!
- **Pomona** helped with the YMCA's Healthy Kids Fair on April 17 by serving a healthy Kiwanis lunch of hot dogs, hamburgers and **Cheetos**®. Doctors and medical students from Pomona's Western University were on hand to measure vital signs... **May 1** is the City's Beautification Day sponsored by the Pomona Chamber of Commerce, and the Club will be doing a cleanup project at Barfield School on that day.
